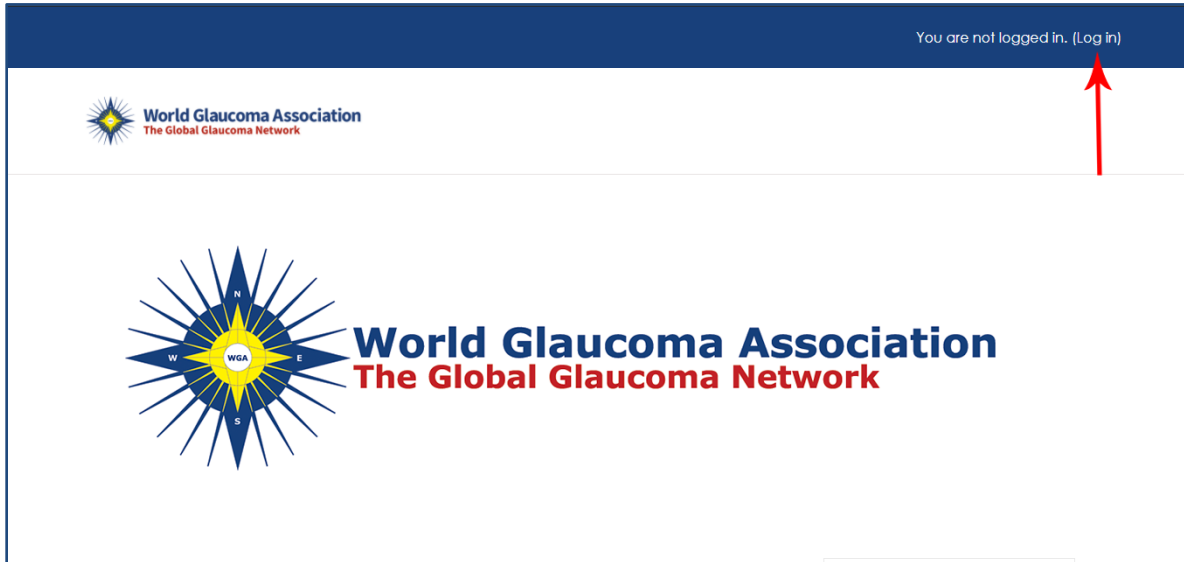
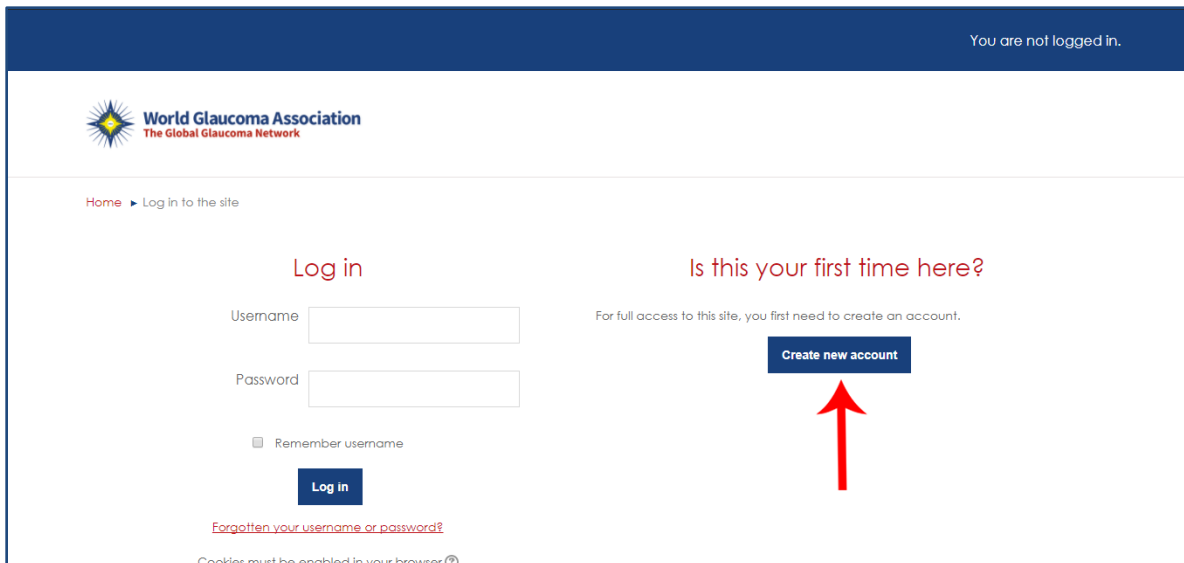


In order to access the platform you must follow the following steps:

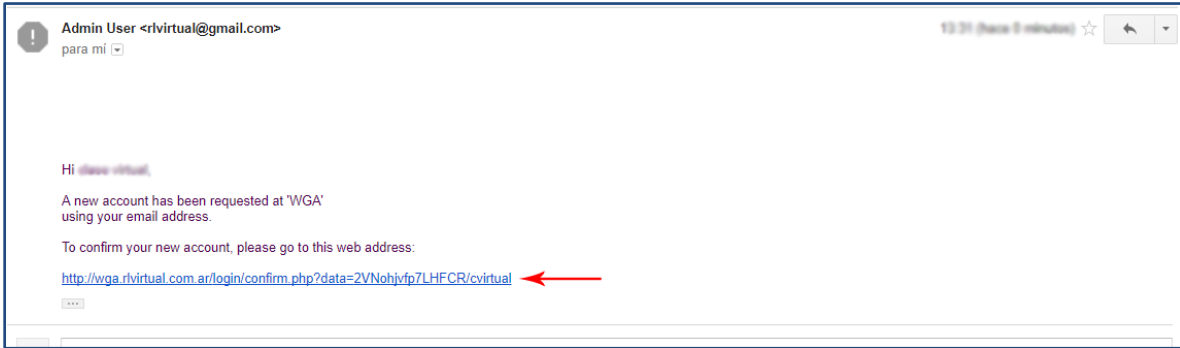

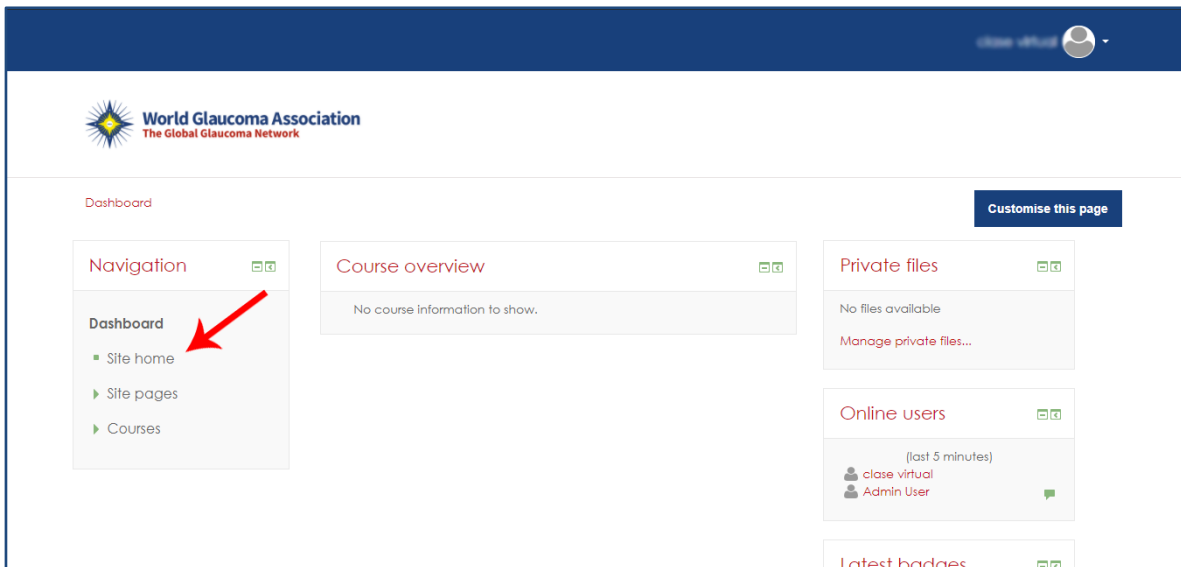


