


Log-in using the information printed on your badge: Registration number and family name. The full registration number, found on the back of your badge, including **WGC** and **all numbers and other characters** should be entered.



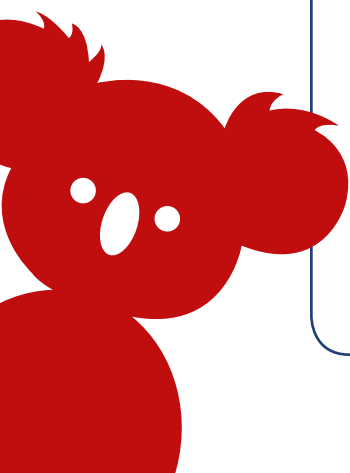
