## IGR statistics: production


- The average number of publications in Glaucoma is rapidly growing and thus is the number of abstracts to review prior to soliciting expert comments: It roughly tripled since 1999
- The database now holds over 40,000 searchable and categorized abstracts (by IGR's unique classification system)
- Of these abstracts, more than 2,100 are commented on by 600+ experts from around the world
- AVG abstracts reviewed per issue: 778. Measured over issues > vol. 20





## IGR statistics: issue downloads

- AVG PDF download: 63,286 (measured over issues > vol. 9)
- 21-3 broke all records with > 100,000 downloads!
- 22-1 was published in October and dissemination is still underway
- 22-2 is under preparation and planned to be published in December






